## Read These Notes Before Completing Application Form

The Rose Education Foundation is keen to support the provision of quality youthwork and youthworkers through our annual grant scheme, extending the work being offered to young people in North East England. We ask that you read the following notes carefully before completing your application.

Your application must reach us by **30<sup>th</sup> November**. As the awarding panel aim to meet in early December applications received after this date will not be considered for this round of funding.

Applications will only be considered if they meet **ALL** of the following criteria:

- The application is from, or is supported by, a Christian organisation or church.
- You are applying for funding for work with **young people aged 11-18**, based in the **North-East of England**.
- You are applying for funding to serve the community and improve the lives of young people.

**You may NOT apply** for funding for your organisation's core costs; this includes, but is not limited to, wages for permanent staff, costs of own premises (rent, heating, electricity etc.), staff equipment (office computers, photocopiers etc.) or vehicles. However, **you may apply** for funding towards additional sessional staff or professionally skilled instructors, equipment that it used directly by young people or that provides services to them (sports equipment, Bibles etc.) or the hire of extra facilities required for specific services or activities.

**You will be notified of the outcome of your application by 31<sup>st</sup> January, but hopefully sooner.** Where grants are awarded the Rose Education Foundation will require a written notification when funds have been received. We may ask for a report, or the opportunity to visit the project, in order to monitor how funds are being used.
